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From April 23 to 24, runners and history buffs alike will unite for a truly unique event, combining both famous American landmarks from the Civil War era and some of the famous monuments of Washington, D.C. During this two-day period, runners will trek 200 miles from Gettysburg, Pa., to Washington, D.C.

Organized into teams of 12, participants will run different legs of the course.

Starting in Gettysburg, the course passes through Michaux State Forest before crossing into Maryland. From there, runners will pass through Boonsboro and Antietam, then West Virginia's Shepherdstown and Harpers Ferry on the way to Great Falls, Va., before ultimately finishing at the Southwest Waterfront in Washington, D.C.
